**Subject: Change in labeled storage conditions: Vasopressin in 0.9% Sodium Chloride Injection, 20 units per 100mL (0.2 units/mL), and 40 units per 100mL (0.4 units/mL)**

Dear Healthcare Professional,

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has approved a change to the labeled room temperature storage condition for Vasopressin in 0.9% Sodium Chloride Injection. Vasopressin in 0.9% Sodium Chloride Injection is now approved to be stored at room temperature for up to 6 months once taken out of the refrigerated condition.

You may have already received certain lot numbers of Vasopressin in 0.9% Sodium Chloride Injection that were manufactured prior to the FDA approval of the updated storage condition. These lots contain the following information in the prescribing information and on the product label: ***Storage Information: Store in the refrigerator (2°C to 8°C [36°F to 46°F]), use within 72 hours once taken out of refrigerated condition.***

The updated prescribing information and product labeling states to ***Store in the refrigerator (2°C to 8°C [36°F to 46°F]), Vasopressin in Sodium Chloride Injection may be stored at room temperature up to 25°C (77°F) for up to 6 months. Discard after 6 months if stored at room temperature or until the expiration date printed on the carton and container label, whichever is earlier. Once stored at room temperature, do not place back in the refrigerator. The drug product must be stored in its light protective carton during storage.***

The change in storage condition was approved by FDA based on updated stability data for Vasopressin in 0.9% Sodium Chloride Injection. There have been no changes in formulation or manufacturing process. Therefore, this new room temperature allowance can be applied to all existing manufactured lots of Vasopressin in 0.9% Sodium Chloride Injection.
